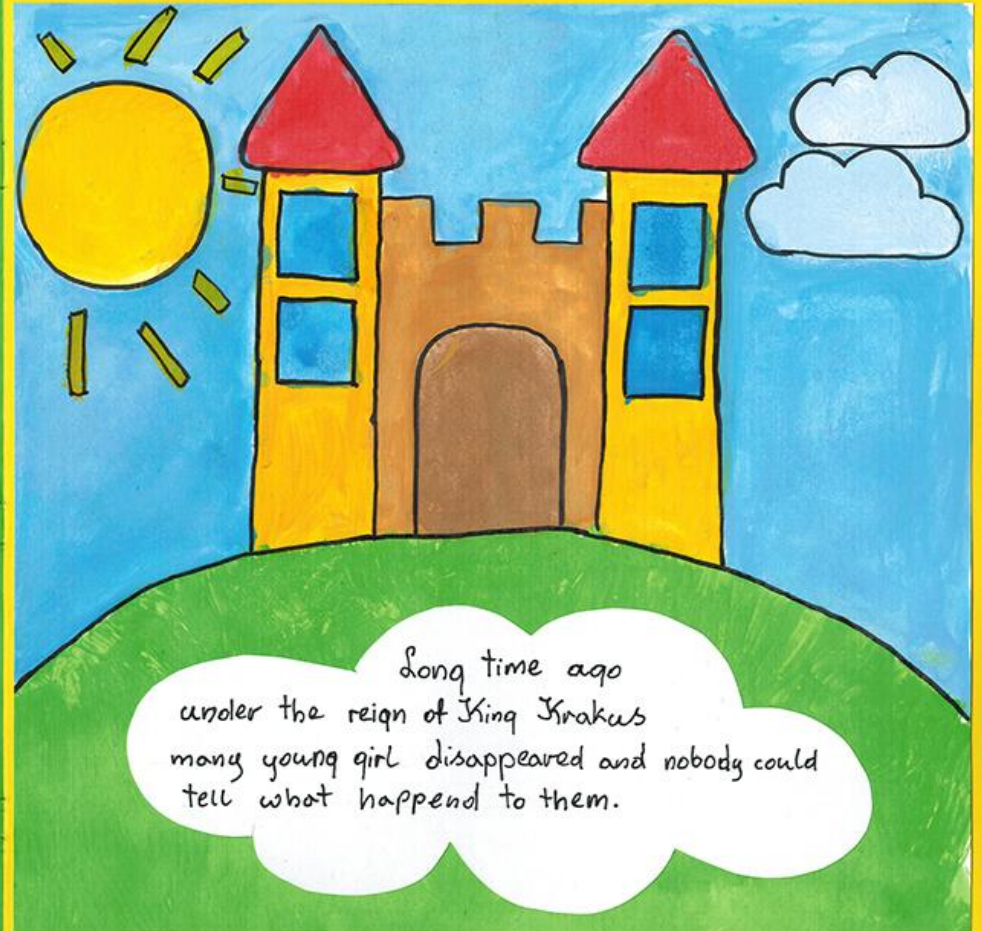

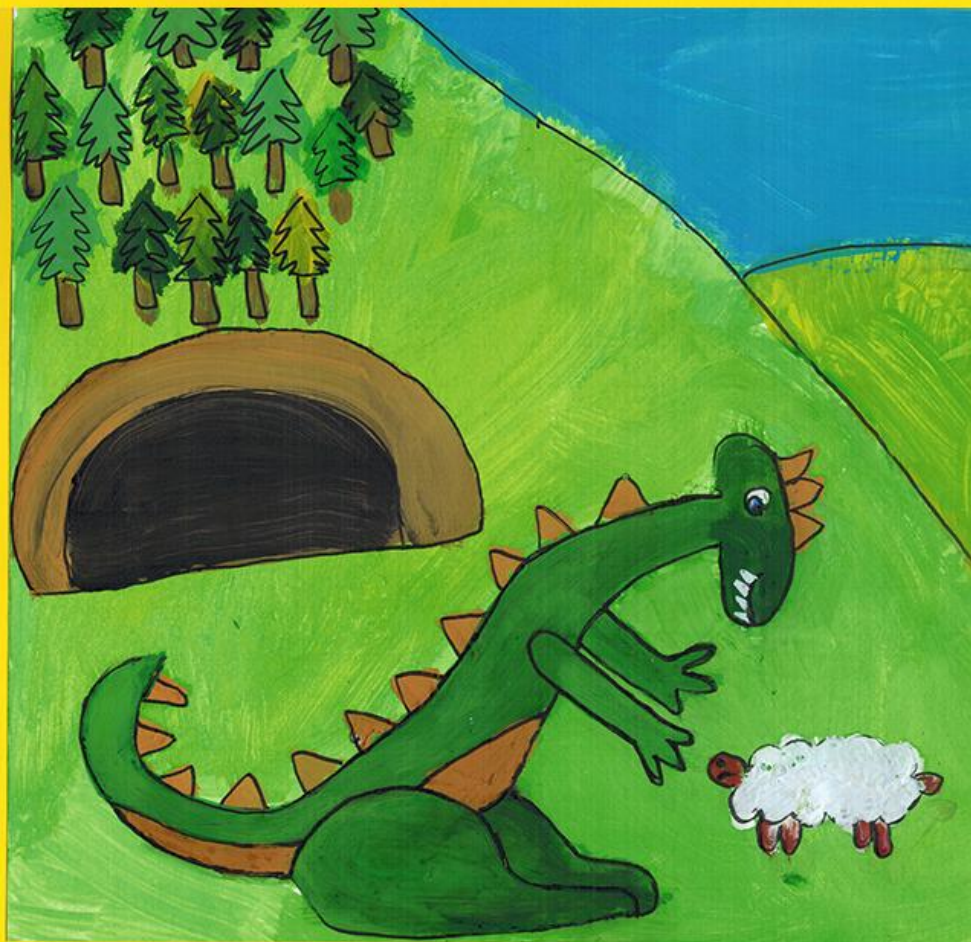

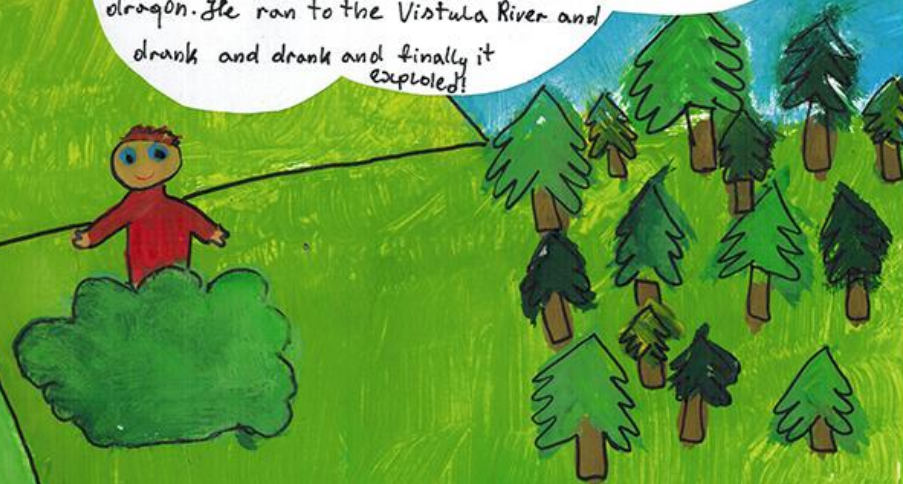
Long time ago
